

# **Dark Green Mag**

**Premium Wordpress theme**

## **Set-Up Guide**

## Step 1: Download and install Dark Green Mag:

You have already downloaded the zip file *darkgreenmagg.zip*. You will find 2 folders in the theme pack.

### 1. Dark Green Mag

### 2. Plugin required for the theme.

Upload the the plugins to your *site/wp-content/plugins* folder via FTP. Once uploaded, go to the plugin section of your wordpress admin panel and activate the plugins. Next upload the theme folder to your *site/wp-content/themes* folder via FTP. Once uploaded activate the theme via the design section of admin panel.

## Step 2:

**Customization:** Once the theme is installed go to the custom theme option (*Dark Green Mag Option*) page of the Dark Green Mag theme. You will find different options which deals with the various modules of this magazine theme. I will explain them one by one.

### 1. Featured content gallery



Featured content gallery is the module located at the top part of the theme. It shows a content glider with images of 640 x 350 , which is associated with posts via a custom field. You can select a particular category and number of posts to display in this module. Once a category and number is selected, the module will display images from the latest posts of that category.

Note: Click on **setting** and then click on **Featured content gallery** to update the gallery settings

Enter category name, number of item to display ( 4 or 5 is good) gallery width :640 , gallery height:350 and text overlay height : 50 (if you want to enter your custom height you can check which is suitable for you)

You can assign these images to posts via custom fields. After making a post scroll down to the custom field section and enter the following custom field values.

Custom field key - **articleimg** ( *case sensitive* )

Custom field value - **url of the image**

## 2. Post Thumbnail

Each post have an image (165 x115 px) associated with it. This image is entered via custom fields. The custom field key and value for displaying images with post is as given below.

## 3. Featured Video Settings

There is a section on the sidebar which will display the featured video of your site. The video code for this section is placed in the box called „Featured Video“

Make sure to resize your embedded video size is not more than width=320px height=240 px to avoid overlapping.

### *Featured Video*

Displays a video embedded on your sidebar .

#### 4. Banner ad Settings

There are four 125x125 banner ads located on the sidebar. You can enter the banner image url and the link via theme option page.

There are user author image banner and text description located on the sidebar. You can enter the banner image url and the about me text via theme option page.

## 6. Adsense Setting

There are adsense advertisement located on your sidebar, on top and bottom and on header . You can enter the adsense code via theme option page.

300x250 banners on the sidebar

468x60 banners on the post

468x60 banners on the header.

## 7. Feedburner Setting

There are feedburner subscribe bar located on your sidebar. You can enter the feed burner code via theme option page. You have to create an account at feed burner to get your feed burner code.
